Helping Homeless at Lee County Stand Down Event

The Lee County Homeless Coalition & the Lee County Continuum of Care (CoC) sponsored a Homeless Service Day and Veteran's Stand Down on Saturday, January 29th.

As a key partner in the CoC, Goodwill SWFL was there assisting attendees. A variety of services were offered to individuals and families experiencing homelessness. Goodwill provided individuals with gift cards worth \$25 each, redeemable at any of our stores.

Goodwill SWFL part of a Multi-Agency Resource Center (MARC) for Tornado Recovery Effort

Lee County commissioners authorized the opening of a multi-agency resource center to aid residents impacted by the Jan. 16 tornado with the opportunity for one-stop, easy accessfor assistance. The center was open 10am to 5pm from Jan. 22 - Feb. 5 at the Wa-Ke Hatchee Recreation Center. Organizations assessed individual needs and worked to allocate available



resources. Goodwill also provided \$25 gift cards for each family member (up to \$100/family) to purchase items at Goodwill. The latest damage assessment from the storm is 74 homes destroyed, 61 homes with major damage and 58 with minor damage.

Expanding Workforce Training Opportunities
