We are offering and providing **self-paced Digital Training** to Royal Ambassador seniors from Mt. Hermon Church at the Tice CRC every Tuesday from 11:00 a.m. - noon until Tuesday, November 7th. A second group of individuals are ready to start a second session of Digital Training. Individuals are reviewing mousing, typing skills, basic computer, and basic internet knowledge and skills.



4-Week Employability Workshop Series

In partnership with Urban Strategies, Inc., we are providing the local residents with a 4-week **Employability Workshop** series with rotating topics, Resume Creation, Job Search Navigation, Interview Skills, and Dressing to Impress.

Training is held at the City of Fort Myers Housing Authority at the Renaissance Preserve (CSS Building). The first series began September 20th and is held every Wednesday from 11:30 am - 1:00 pm, through October 11th. Upon completion of the workshop series, a professional attire voucher is provided which enables them to purchase clothes for their interview, or with other needs for employment purposes.
