# Breakthrough Volunteer Steve Johnson

Steve Johnson has worked as a product manager for two very large corporations and co-founded a multi-million-dollar hightech business, which he helped start from scratch. Now that he is retired, he volunteers his time by sharing his business experience with Goodwill's MicroEnterprise students.

"I see them come in the door all googleeyed thinking, what did I get myself into, and about midway through the course they say, I got it!" says Steve. "That's the ah-ha moment, and when they complete the course they are confident people. That's my satisfaction."

MicroEnterprise is a 6-week small business program that helps local entrepreneurs take that next step into creating a small business.

"A student comes to us and has a business idea, but we help them get it down on paper," Steve explains. "The end product is what we call a feasibility plan which is about 70% of a business plan. At that point,

"It was tough. It's a rigorous class," said Steve. "The course is beautifully designed and skillfully executed by the staff."

Steve is dedicated to making a difference, reserving several days a week just to focus on MicroEnterprise. He says, volunteering as a coach is very rewarding.

ideally, they will get linked up to a SCORE mentor who will help them turn that feasibility plan into a business plan and execute it."

Even though Steve spent his career developing products and taking them to market, he felt taking the class first would help him coach it more successfully.

"I've been a coach now about 5 years. I will tell you that it's been satisfying. It's been fun. It's been challenging," laughed Steve. "And, when the teaching team goes home at night, we are in high spirits. As we are walking out the door, there is a smile on everyone's face and we are sharing little guips. It's fun."
